Lili (formerly Olivier) Kimmoun was a student at Ecole Nationale Supérieure in Cachan, near Paris. After graduating she moved to Marseille where she got a PhD at the *Laboratoire Interaction Océan Atmosphère* of IRPHE, in Luminy. Her PhD was a theoretical and experimental study of crossed seas. Then she joined the just starting hydrodynamic group at Ecole Supérieure d'Ingénieurs de Marseille (ESIM), to take charge of the newly built wave flume. Later she was appointed associate professor at Ecole Centrale Marseille. From 2000 Lili was a regular participant at the workshops, where she initiated many collaborations with foreign colleagues all around the world. Lili had many talents, sailing, climbing, devising and running elaborate experiments, cooking, making friends, helping colleagues with computer problems, supervising and helping students. We miss her.
